### Ornamental Evergreen Trees/Shrubs:

The weeping ornamentals are all different, no two plants are the same, and therefore the maturity size specifications and ultimate looks are all unique. Pruning can help shape the preferred size and look.



**Weeping Colorado Spruce**, Can grow 20' to 30' tall and wide.



**Weeping White Pine**, Grows 7' tall and 10' wide, depending on growth pattern.



**Weeping Norway Spruce**, Straight or Fish hook style. Can grow up to 25' to 30' tall and 5' to 8' wide depending on growth pattern.



**Weeping Alaskan Cedar**, 35' tall and 15' wide.



**Weeping Beech 'Purple Fountain'**, Slow growing 10-12' tall and 15' wide.



**Globe Blue Spruce, on a standard,** Grafted on a 'standard' it has an ornamental Height will depend on the height of the graft, average 3-5' tall by 5-6' wide.



**'Cloud' pruning on Junipers,** height and width depends on specimen selected.



**Twisted Weeping Blue Atlas Cedar**, the twisted trunk and weeping foliage make these plants real attention getters. Nice accent plant. Grows 10-15' tall but depends on how it is trained.



**Dwarf White Pine on Standard**, long, soft blue-green needles. Grafted on a 'standard' it has an ornamental lollipop look and serves well as a specimen plant. Slow growth to 6 ft x 6 ft. Ultimate height will depend on the height of the graft.

## **Evergreen Tree Ideas (tall):**



**Umbrella Pine**

Grows 25-30' tall and 15-20' wide.



**Concolor Fir (White Fir)**

Grows 40-70' tall and 20' wide. Soft blue green foliage.



**Leyland Cypress**

Fast growing, grows up to 3' each year. Eventually grows 50' tall and 20' wide.



**Red Cedar**

Grows 30-65' tall and 8-25' wide.



**Juniper 'Hetzii Columnaris'**

Grows 10-15' tall and 5' wide.



**Serbian Spruce**

Grows 40-60' tall and 15-20' wide.



**Oriental Spruce**

Grows 60-80' tall and 20-30' wide.



**Canadian Hemlock**

Grows 40' tall and 25' wide.

**Evergreen Trees:**



**Dwarf Blue Spruce**, Colorado; slow growing (2-3" a year). Maturity of 12' tall and 6-7' wide.



**Blue Point Juniper**, Blue gray tones. Grows 8-10' tall and 4-5' wide.



**Arborvitae**, there are many varieties and sizes, some are more Deer resistant than others, but Deer tend to love them. Average height is 10-20' tall and average width is 4-8' wide.



**Candicans White Fir**, 30-50' tall and 15-30' wide.



**Oregon Green Austrian Pine**, 20' tall and 15' wide.



**Goldy Western Arborvitae**, 15-20' tall and 3-5' wide. Orange highlights in cold weather. Grows about 1' a year. Weight of snow may make it bend. Staking is recommended.



**Cripp's Golden Cypress**, 10-15' tall and 8-10' wide.



**Gnom Common Juniper**, 10-12' tall and 3-4' wide.



**Sky Pencil Holly**, 8' tall and 2' wide.

## **Evergreen Shrubs:**



**Mugo pine, 3-5' tall, 6-10' wide (slow growing)**



**Bird's Nest Spruce, 3-5' tall, 4-6' wide.**



**Dwarf Golden Threadleaf False Cypress, 3' tall and wide.**



**Dwarf White Pine**, soft, silver-green needles. Slow, compact growth to 3 ft x 3 ft. Sun to partial shade. Sensitive to salt spray.



**Dwarf Blue globe spruce**, 3-5' tall by 5-6' wide.



**Globe Arborvitae**, rounded shrub with dark evergreen foliage. Light shearing gives arborvitae additional strength and shape. 2-4' tall and wide.



**Hetz Midget Arborvitae**, 3-4' tall and wide.



**Mr. Bowling Ball Arborvitae**, rich green color in a compact soft, round habit.  
Grows 2-3' tall and wide.



**Green Velvet Boxwood**, (Many Varieties of Boxwood Available). Maturing to a height of 4-6 ft., this boxwood is a popular choice for hedges, border plantings, and edging.



Gold Mop Cypress, 3' tall and 4' wide.



**Shamrock Inkberry**, 3-4 ft tall and 4-5ft wide.



**Holly**, (Many Varieties Available). Need one Male in an area to pollinate Female plants in order to get berries. Some varieties can get 10-12' tall and 8-10' wide, great for a hedge.



**Emerald Magic Holly**, Grows 4 feet tall and wide. Dense, compact, shiny green foliage.



**Japanese Holly (Helleri)**, Compact strong branched habit. Smaller leaves than the American holly. Keeps shape nicely. Grows 2-3 feet tall and 4-5 feet wide.



**Dwarf Western Red Cedar, 'Grune Kugel'**, 3' tall by 4' wide.

**Rhododendrons**, (Many Varieties Available).



**Nova Zembla**, 5' tall by wide.



Towhead Rhododendron, Blooms early spring. Grows 2-3' tall and 3-4' wide.



'Maximum Roseum' Grows 8-12' tall and wide.



'Roseum Elegans' Grows 6-8' tall and wide.



PJM, Grows 6-8' tall and wide.



'English Roseum' Grows 6-8' tall and wide.



**Milky Way**, 3-4' tall and 4-5' wide.



**Dreamland**, 3-4' tall and 3-5' wide.



**Haaga**, 3-4' tall and 3-4' wide.



**Chionoides**, Grows 4' tall and 6' wide

**Azaleas**, (Many Varieties Available)



*Hino Crimson*, Azalea 2-4'tall by 3-5' wide.

**Andromeda**, (Many Varieties Available)



**Andromeda Cavatine**, Blooms in the spring. Grows 2-3' tall and wide.



***Mountain Fire***, 4' tall and wide (white flowers)



***Brouwer's Beauty***, 3-5' tall and wide.

## **Evergreen Ground Cover Ideas:**



***Blue Pacific Juniper***, 1' tall by 7' wide.



**Gray Owl Juniper**, 3' tall by 6' wide.



**Russian Cypress**, 1 to 1 1/2' tall and 6-8' wide. The green foliage turns to a bronze brown in the fall and winter.



**Lime glow Juniper**, 1' tall by 3' wide.



**Blue Star Juniper**, 2-3' tall by 3-4' wide.



**Pachysandra**, evergreen perennial, grows 8-12" tall.



**Myrtle**, shiny evergreen perennial, blooms early spring, grows 4-8" tall.
